Record 40-60 case logs or research log	Logs must be dated October 1, 2019 to September 31, 2020

Continuing education	40 hours within 3 years- (October 1, 2017 to October 1, 2020) 10 hours between October 1, 2019 to September 31, 2020
2 Letters of recommendation sent by veterinarian or VTS (Sent separately by the letter writers)	By September 1, 2020
