

Academy of Veterinary Nutrition Technicians Advanced Skills List All qualified candidates will have demonstrated advanced veterinary nursing skills. All VTS (Nutrition) candidates shall demonstrate expertise in the area of veterinary nutrition.

Applicant's Name	

The applicant is required to state whether or not he/she has mastered the skill on the form. Mastery is defined as being able to perform the task safely, with a high degree of success, without being coached or prompted. Mastery requires having performed the task in a wide variety of patients and situations. The AVNT applicant must have 80% of the skills mastered to be considered for application to the AVNT credentialing process.

The AVNT is aware that some states or provinces may not allow a task to be performed by a credentialed veterinary technician. The AVNT requires that a Veterinary Technician Specialist (Nutrition or Internal Medicine) or a veterinarian who has mastered the skill, attest to your mastery of the skill.
